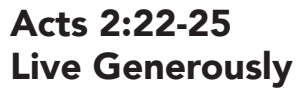

One pastor said, "you can't take it with you, but you can send it on ahead." What does it look like practically for us to take this seriously today? How do we do this?

6. Read Malachi 3:7-10.
- The Old Testament law for tithing is no longer mandated for New Testament Christians. What relevance does the principle and heart of God regarding tithing and giving of your "first fruits" look like today?

7. Share in what ways God has been challenging you in the area of generosity.
